With the introduction of clay targets, the sport began to take on the popular form known today. Sporting clay courses are designed to simulate the hunting of ducks, pheasants and rabbits. Six different sizes of clay targets give the participant the experience of actual hunting conditions. We take your group to a State Certified Sporting



Clay Course with a certified instructor. Walk the woods to thirteen stations with four shots at each station. Instruction and equipment provided.

GROUP RECREATIONAL ACTIVITIES

▣ CEDAR POINT AMUSEMENT PARK

Cedar Point has been voted Best Amusement Park in the World by *Amusement Today* for eight consecutive years. Cedar Point boasts 16 incredible coasters and more than 65 rides offering the ultimate in excitement and variety. Only 6 miles from the resort, the park is open May-August and weekends Sept. & Oct.

▣ CHARTER FISHING

Board the charter boats at the resort's Mariner Village Marina on Lake Erie to enjoy a day on the lake. Experienced captains piloting 6-pack charters (6pp per boat) take fishermen to the lake's "hot spots" to catch walleye or perch. Ohio fishing license can be acquired prior to boarding.

▣ WATER SPORTS AT THE BEACH

Unwind on Sawmill's private Lake Erie beach. Ride jet skis, fly on a parasail, play beach volleyball, swim and cook hot dogs and marshmallows at the bonfire.

▣ FLY FISHING

Walk the banks along winding streams shaded by lush willow trees. At a private trout club, guests are provided with fly rods, bait and instruction. The clubhouse, a renovated Georgian mansion, provides a lounge, dining room, snack food and beverages. Catch and release or a nominal cost per pound.

▣ LAKE ERIE ISLAND TOUR

Put-in-Bay has been a tourist destination since 1864. Victorian era buildings dominate the

main street which is alive with an eclectic mix of shops, restaurants, pubs, wineries and even caves. Dominating the boat harbor is Perry's Monument commemorating Commodore Perry's defeat of the British during the Battle of Lake Erie. Travel around the island by bike, golf carts or trams for an afternoon or evening of fun. Two ferry lines cruise across Lake Erie to the island.

▣ LET'S GO SHOPPING!

Quaint experiences await at Milan, OH and the Naturally Country Store. Shop for antiques, books, dried and silk flower arrangements, wreaths, home accessories, unique toys, baskets, pottery and yard ornaments. The Sawmill Creek Shops, in a barn built in 1887, houses men's & women's clothing, gourmet kitchen shop, books, unique home accessories and gifts.



▣ TOUR OHIO WINERIES

The warm waters of Lake Erie extend our season creating perfect temperatures for growing grapes for wine. Visit Firelands Winery in Sandusky or Mon Ami Winery on the Catawba Island Peninsula to enjoy the taste of prize winning local wines. Gift shops offer wine related treasures and wine by the bottle or case.



▣ DAY SPA EXPERIENCE

▣ SAWMILL CREEK GOLF COURSE

Tom Fazio designed large undulating greens that support a variety of pin placements to satisfy the most demanding playing conditions. Strategically placed sand bunkers dot the fairways and guard against errant approach shots onto the green. Frequent lake breezes add to the challenge of having water hazards come into play on 14 separate holes. Ask about corporate outings, steak fries, and clinics with our PGA Pro.



▣ SAWMILL EXPLORER LAKE ERIE CRUISE

The "Dispatch" was built in 1954 in Sandusky, Ohio. For over 20 years, it ferried vacationers to Cedar Point from Sandusky's harbor. Now, renamed the "Sawmill Explorer," it continues a long history of service. The Sawmill Explorer takes up to 50 resort guests on cruises along the shoreline of Lake Erie and the Huron River. Come discover the beauty of Lake Erie and getaway for scenic or cocktail cruises.

▣ SHELDON MARSH NATURE PRESERVE

A short walk from The Lodge, this preserve and contiguous wetlands comprise some of the last remaining undeveloped stretches of shoreline in the Sandusky Bay region. The main path through the woods, past the wetlands, was the original automobile entrance to Cedar Point Amusement Park in the early 1900's. Walk the trail to the barrier beach for a spectacular view of Lake Erie. Self-guided or arrange for a guide.
